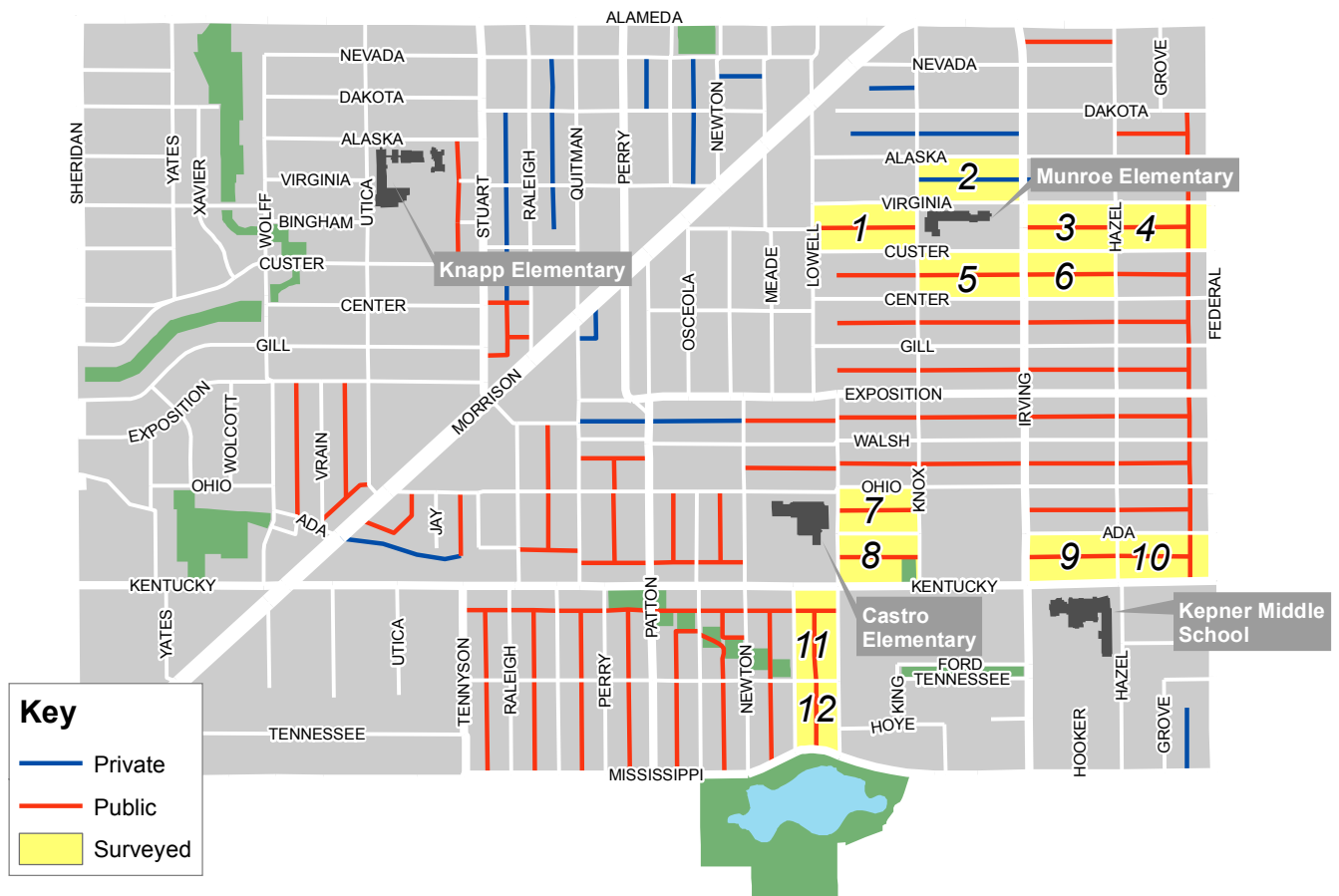


Westwood Alley Project
